Vital Statistics

Vital Records is responsible for filing Birth and Death Records within the City of Wichita Falls and acknowledgement of paternity.

Records issued are:

- ◆ Certified Birth Certificates for persons born within the City of WF from 1917 to present.
- ◆ Certified Death Certificates for persons that died within the City of WF from 1917 to present.
- ◆ Birth Certificates for persons born in Texas from 1926 to present have minimal information provided by the State.

Women, Infants & Children (WIC)

WIC is a federally funded supplemental food and nutrition program for eligible:

- ◆ Pregnant women
- ◆ Postpartum and nursing mothers
- ◆ Infants and children up to age 5

WIC helps families eat well and stay healthy by providing:

- ◆ Nutrition education
- ◆ Supplemental food benefits
- ◆ Breastfeeding education and support
- ◆ Breast pumps
- ◆ Growth check-ups for children
- ◆ Health care referrals, including immunizations



Our WIC Agency is a milk depot for Mothers' Milk Bank of North Texas:

- ◆ Donated milk is collected and distributed to critically ill and premature infants.
- ◆ Donor milk is uniquely superior and can be lifesaving for fragile infants.

- ◆ Increase cessation among youth and adults
- ◆ Eliminate exposure to secondhand smoke
- ◆ Reduce tobacco use among populations with the highest burden of tobacco-related health disparities
- ◆ Develop and maintain statewide capacity for comprehensive tobacco prevention and control
