The following changes to the plans, specifications, and contract documents for the 2019 Lift Station 36, 44 & 47 Rehabilitation Project, CWF19-550-07, shall supersede the appropriate parts of the original plans and specifications and shall be incorporated as part of the contract.

Bidding Requirements: New Bid Date: Bids are due by **3:00 PM on August 27, 2019** in Room 113 of Memorial Auditorium, 1300 7th Street, Wichita Falls, TX 76301. Bids will be opened and read aloud at 3:15 PM in Room 500 of Memorial Auditorium. The new Engineer's Estimate is \$175,000.

Lift Station 47 shall be a **Wilco EMU FA10.82E with Motor T20.1-4/22KEx** rated for 1100 GPM at 46 feet of TDH with 480V 3 Phase power. Replace with this pump and motor in all locations of the plans specified for LS47.

On Sheet 15 of the plans, the existing power to Lift Station 47 is **480V 3 Phase**. The Contractor shall order a 480V 3 Phase motor. Page Q-18 of the specifications correctly calls out a 480V 3 Phase motor.

Lift Station 36 and associated pay items have been removed from the project. Items removed include: Item 203.3 Site Prep, Item 600-PMLF Install New Pump and Motor (Low Flow), Item 702.8-1 Install Concrete Wet Well, and Item 801.5 6' Chainlink Fence. Any cost associated with the Site Prep item shall be subsidiary to Item 200.1 Mobilization.

Addendum No. 2 supersedes Addendum No.1. Bidders should only return and sign Addendum No. 2 with their bid proposals.

The Bidder, in compliance with your Notice to Bidders for the **2019 Lift Station 36, 44 and 47 Rehabilitation Project, CWF19-559-97**, a project generally described as: **the rehabilitation of Lift Stations 36, 44 and 47 including the replacement of pumps, motors, control panels, and removal of Lift Station 44**, and associated work: having thoroughly examined the plans, specifications, Instructions to Bidders, Notice to Bidders, and all of the other related contract documents as amended by proper addenda, and the site(s) of the proposed work and being familiar with all of the conditions surrounding the construction of the proposed project including the availability of materials and labor, hereby proposes to furnish all labor, materials, and supplies; and to construct the project in accordance with the plans, specifications and contract documents, as amended by proper addenda, in accordance with the time set forth therein and at the prices stated in Attachment A.

The Bidder confirms that the General Provisions and the standard specifications for this contract are located in the **Public Works Construction Standards – North Central Texas**, October, 2004. This publication is available through the North Central Texas Council of Governments' Regional Information Center, P.O. Box 5888, Arlington, TX 76005-5888, Phone: 817-640-3300.

Accompanying this Bid Proposal is a cashier's check, certified check, or acceptable bid bond (in general agreement with the provisions of the form provided) in the total amount of \$_____ (not less than five percent of the maximum amount Bid) made payable to the City of Wichita Falls, Texas. The bid security will be returned to the Bidder unless, in case of award, the undersigned fails to execute a contract and file the required bonds and insurance within fourteen (14) calendar days of the date of receipt of a written Notice of Award, in which case it shall be retained by the Owner as liquidated damages due to delay and other inconveniences suffered by the Owner as a result of such failure on the part of the Bidder.

It is understood that the City of Wichita Falls reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

It is understood that the quantities of work to be done at unit prices indicated on Attachment A are approximate only and are intended principally to serve as a guide in evaluating bids. It is

further agreed that, subject to the constraints of the General Provisions, the quantities of work to be done and materials to be furnished at the unit prices bid may be increased or decreased as may be considered necessary, in the opinion of the Engineer, to complete the work fully as planned and contemplated, and that all quantities of work, whether increased or decreased are to be performed at the unit prices set forth except as provided for in the General Provisions.

Bidder hereby agrees to commence work under this contract within fourteen (14) calendar days of the date specified in a written "Notice to Proceed" by the Engineer of the City of Wichita Falls, and to complete the project within **one hundred fifty (150)** calendar days thereafter as stipulated in the General Provisions. Liquidated damages are set forth in the General Provisions.

In the event of the award of a contract to the undersigned by the City Council of the City of Wichita Falls, Texas, the undersigned will furnish Performance and Warranty, and Payment Bonds in the amount required, to secure proper compliance with the terms and provision of the contract, to guarantee and insure the work until final completion and acceptance and to guarantee payment of all lawful claims for labor performed and materials furnished in the fulfillment of the contract.

The undersigned certifies that the bid prices shown on Attachment A have been carefully checked and are submitted as correct and final.

All addenda have been signed and submitted with the bid proposal.
