## **Sixth Confirmed COVID-19 Travel Case**

Wichita Falls, Texas – The Wichita Falls-Wichita County Public Health District reports the sixth confirmed COVID-19 travel case. The patient is in their 20's and attended college out of state. The patient flew into DFW on March 19, 2020 and then flew into Wichita Falls on Flight 3612 which arrived at 9:59AM. The patient began experiencing mild symptoms on March 18. On March 21, they were administered the COVID-19 test at a drive-up testing facility in Wichita Falls. After the test was administered and then a stop at CVS, the patient has been in isolation at home since March 21.

- March 19: Walmart located at 3130 Lawrence Road
- March 19: Aldi's located at 3121 Lawrence Road
- March 19: Natural Grocers located at 3910 Lawrence Road
- March 19: Forest Bend Apartments Leasing Office located at 5248 Professional Drive
- March 21: CVS located at 4600 Southwest Parkway
