Laboratory Services

Our Laboratory is both CLIA & NELAP accredited and provides the following services:

- ◆ Food & Environmental Sample Testing
- ◆ Potable & Non-Potable Water Testing

Private well owners are encouraged to regularly test their water wells for the presence of bacteria to ensure that the well water remains free from contamination. A well water test kit is available that includes an information booklet for added convenience. Well water samples are accepted Monday-Thursday before 3pm.

Women, Infants & Children (WIC)

WIC is a federally funded supplemental food and nutrition program for eligible:

- ◆ Pregnant women
- ◆ Postpartum & nursing mothers
- ◆ Infants & children up to age 5



WIC helps families eat well and stay healthy by providing:

- ◆ Nutrition education
- ◆ Supplemental food benefits
- ◆ Breastfeeding education
- ◆ Breast pumps
- ◆ Growth check-ups for children
- ◆ Health care referrals, including immunizations



Our WIC agency is a milk depot for Mothers' Milk Bank of North Texas:

- ◆ Donated milk is collected, pasteurized, and distributed to critically ill and premature infants.
- ◆ Donor milk is uniquely superior and can be lifesaving for fragile infants
