#### Animal Services Clear the Shelters

Wichita Falls, Texas – The City of Wichita Falls Animal Services Center is overflowing with dogs, cats, kittens, and puppies looking for a forever home. In an effort to find homes for these animals, the Animal Services Center is participating in the nationwide Clear the Shelters event to bring awareness to the plight of homeless animals in our community. City of Wichita Falls Animal Services will be waiving adoption fees from Monday, September 13, 2021, through Saturday, September 18, 2021. Potential adopters can visit and meet with adoptable animals waiting on their forever homes.

Adoption includes the following for each animal:

- Vaccinations,
- Worming,
- Feline Leukemia testing for cats,
- Heartworm testing for dogs six (6) months and older,
- Flea and tick preventative, and
- Microchipping.

Adopters must pre-pay for the animal to be spayed or neutered at their veterinarian of choice. Adopted animals six months or older will be taken to the chosen veterinarian's office by Animal Services staff. Puppies and kittens under six months of age will be given a date for when the procedure must be completed.
