Denton Bomb Squad and WFFD to Hold Joint Training Exercise

Wichita Falls, Texas- The Denton Bomb Squad and Wichita Falls Fire Department are joining in a comprehensive training exercise. It will take place at the WFFD Drill Field in the 1300 block of Harding in Wichita Falls.

The training will be taking place from 2 pm to 4 pm on July 12-14, 2023. This joint training operation aims to enhance the skills and preparedness of local emergency response teams.

During this training period, citizens in the vicinity of the Drill Field may experience intermittent sounds of explosions. These controlled detonations are part of the training exercise and pose no threat to the safety or well-being of the community.

The joint training exercise will simulate real-life scenarios and enable both agencies to develop and refine strategies, techniques, and coordination. Safety is the priority for both the public and emergency responders.

Should residents be concerned when they witness or hear sounds of explosions during the training period, rest assured that every precaution has been taken to mitigate any potential risks associated with the training exercise.
