## **Wichita Falls Citizen's Academy Set for 2024**

Wichita Falls, Texas – Citizens of Wichita Falls are invited to take part in the Citizens Academy starting in March. The Academy gives residents the chance to see some of the inter-workings of the City and ask questions while meeting with City leaders.

Citizens will start by learning how Wichita Falls is run and what goes into keeping the city moving and operating on a day-to-day basis. Residents will also get to visit the Police and Fire Departments for a first-hand look at training. Other topics include City Council roles and responsibilities, general City services such as Public Works, Community Development and Planning, and many other Wichita Falls-focused municipal topics.

The Wichita Falls Citizens Academy is a great way to develop relationships with City staff while learning more about their responsibilities, and finding ways to become more involved.

Classes will be held on Thursdays, from 6 pm to 8:30 pm, beginning March 28, 2024. The format will be a mixture of class and activity settings. The minimum age for enrollment is 18 years of age. The application deadline is March 1, 2024.

The Academy will conclude at the City Council meeting on Tuesday, May 7, 2023, with a brief graduation presentation.
