Wichita Falls Reclaims Bronze Medal as Bicycle Friendly Community

Wichita Falls, Texas- The City of Wichita Falls has once again been recognized as a Bronze Medal Bicycle Friendly Community by the League of American Bicyclists.

The City is one of 480 communities across the nation to be ranked.

The Bicycle Friendly Community designation is a reflection of local leaders' ongoing work to build better places to bike. Wichita Falls was first awarded the Bronze Medal status in 2019.

The City has and will continue making improvements to allow the cycling community to continue to have safe access to streets and roads in Wichita Falls. Just in the last month, newly designated bike lanes have been marked on streets throughout the city.

The League of American Bicyclists' Bicycle Friendly America program sets the standard for how communities build and benchmark progress toward making biking better. The League strives to provide continual updates to the application as part of our commitment to help communities raise their standards for safety, equity, and accessibility.
