Health District to Host 2024 Health Fair

Wichita Falls, Texas- The Wichita Falls-Wichita County Public Health District will host its Public Health Fair on Thursday, April 4, 2024, from 3 to 6 p.m. at the health district campus, 1700 Third St. in Wichita Falls.

The Health Fair is the Health District's celebration of National Public Health Week, which runs from April 1st to 7th. More than 40 community partners will be on hand to help amplify the WFWCPHD's motto, "A healthy community is a strong community."

This year's theme is "Super Heroes, Super Health", and celebrates the role of Public Health in empowering a healthier and stronger community by preventing illness & injury, promoting health and safety, and protecting our community.

Geared chiefly toward our county's youth, this free health fair will offer activities inside and outside featuring:

- FREE pet adoptions and FREE microchipping (at Animal Services)
- Blood pressure checks
- Scavenger hunt for kids and adults;
- Blood drive;
- TxDOT Rollover Convincer (car accident simulator)
- Door prizes; and more

During the week, the Health District will celebrate the power of prevention, share strategies for successful partnerships, and champion the role of a strong public health system. There will also be activities throughout April to include cooking and health education classes.

In addition to health education classes and health and immunization services at the Wichita Falls - Wichita County Public Health District Main Campus, the district also travels to churches, clubs, and organizations in throughout Wichita County to address the specific health needs of those communities.
